Why Should I Care?

Think of who your reader is - picture that person and write for them.

The reader needs to know what's in it for them from the get go.

If appropriate, you can hook the reader by surprising them, telling them a story, cracking a joke, even throwing in a cheesy pun from line one.

Why Should I Care? Case Study 1

Let's set the stage...

Scene 1- You just got home from a long, tiring day at work. You come in the door, take off your jacket, kick off your shoes, and.... wait.... what's that on the carpet? Is that chocolate or poop? You hope it's the former, but between your kids and the dog, you really can't be sure.




